Levy Fact Sheet

Raise funds for your La Follette team, club, or group by working concessions at UW–Madison events!

How it works

Levy Restaurants is the business that runs all UW–Madison concessions. Local groups sign up to work concessions at UW sporting events, concerts, etc. and earn 10% of all funds raised at that booth.

Who can work

La Follette students 16 and older and adults. There must be at least one adult working at all times. There is no minimum number of participants required; if just a few people can work and you are paired with another organization, Levy will split funds between participating groups based on the number of workers you bring.

Time commitment

Depends on the event. For football games, you may work up to 6 hours (but can make more money); other events may require closer to 3 hours of work.

How much will our club/team/group make?

Your club or group will earn 10% of all sales. In exchange for a few hours of work, La Follette teams and clubs have raised anywhere from \$400 to \$2,500 per event!

Insurance

The La Follette Booster Club, a 501(c)3 organization, pays for annual liability insurance to cover La Follette students and adults who work at Levy.
